

Col. Elias Dayton's newly formed 3rd New Jersey Regiment mustered in New York City on May 1, 1776 and was praised as the best and most complete regiment in the Continental service. Sent to Canada with Brig. Gen. John Sullivan's relief force, it was diverted at Albany to handle Indian-Loyalist concerns in the Mohawk Valley. Come October, after a protracted verbal battle between generals, the entire regiment left to reinforce Fort Ticonderoga, Mount Independence, and their dwindling garrisons. After a difficult winter, they were finally able to return home in the Spring of 1777.
